Enrollment/Budget:

- No changes from last month. We have 35-37 kindergartners right now and the goal is 52, we will settle for 47-48. We lost a few due to choice enrollment. We will not have accurate number until the beginning of next school year. We will have two classes in each grade level.

Staffing:

- We hired Luke Dudley in an on-going contract. We did do a competitive hiring process. We will have two temporary teacher positions for next school year in 2nd and 4th. We have one retirement this year, O'Lynne Nation, and have hired Keri Whitehurst in her place.

CMAS:

- We are on day two with the 3rd & 5th ELA CMAS tests, 4th grade will test in Math next week.
- This year's scores will not count towards school accreditation. We are anticipating that they will fully test next year.

Plan for Next Year:

- Five days a week of in person learning with a full staff. The district is moving on with remote learning. Currently, we have two students that will do the remote learning next year. They would not have teacher's from here though, but will still have ties with Stober; weekly connection. The district is working on how that would look like and they are actively working on hiring the teachers.

Continuation:

- Anne reached out to about 8 or 9 parents to see what they thought. Continuation has to be outside, 4 guests per student, masks required. We know that this is a important celebration for our 5th grade families and we have scheduled it for May 26th.
- Possible dance party. Hire a D.J., do cupcakes and individual wrapped drinks, pop up tents if necessary.

Open Forum:

- We are thinking about having a Grand Opening in the fall.
- The garden will be done soon; the Garden Committee has to raise money.
- 7 News came to Stober and filmed a segment on the importance of Kindergarten.
- Values Awards – besides nominating four staff members the district added to nominate one more for a district level award. Mr. Dudley was nominated and won for Exemplary Performance! We are proud of all of our staff.
- Flex day is at the end of the month, K-3rd will do Acadience testing, 4th-5th will do MAP testing.
- We would still like to do a talent show this year either a video or cohorts outside.

P.I.E. Chair:

- Liz Mason will continue for next year. If anyone is interested for the following year reach out to Liz. It was asked if it a requirement that it is a parent? We do not know and will look into it.
