Giving Tree:

Liz Mason sent out a Sign-up Genius and all was filled within a week. Three gifts per person plus a \$25.00 King Soopers Card to each family. The gifts will be handed out next week.

Kindergarden Information:

We held a Kindergarten Information Zoom Meeting on December 1st and had 19 participants. This was lower than the past years, but given the nature of this year, we were pleased with the turnout. Overall, it went well.

Enroll Jeffco:

We have 24 for kindergarten plus 3 incomplete. The goal for kindergarten is 52. Our total enrollment for this year is 248 students; our building capacity is 271, which this is our goal to reach. Will we have 11 or 12 classroom for next school year? This year we have 13 classroom due to remote learning.

DAC Survey:

Anne and Liz Mason complete the community survey asking what is important to you in your school. The priorities that were voiced were; Tech support, mental health, reading intervention. The district will cut from central areas first but there is only so much they can cut at the central level, so cuts will also happen in the schools.

In the September/October PIE meetings, we shared data; goals were to close the gap within all grade levels in reading. Stober has adapted a new intervention program, Really Great Reading. The staff has spent 12 hours training and targeting areas. The Colorado Read Act, state legislation, has implemented a new mandate for KG through 3rd grades due to the number of students that are below and or not showing any growth. Teachers need an additional 45 hours endorsement as part of this. Therefore, the additional teacher PD days were added so that they can work on this.

Building Update:

The elevator was installed yesterday and concrete was poured outside. They are working on putting in the ceilings next week. The elevator should be done by the end of December early January. The community garden area is being worked on now. Preparing the land and building the stairs will be done by the district. The planter boxes, fences, irrigation will be done by the Community Garden Group. Fund raising \$36,000 to complete. Jeffco took out the ramp and will be putting in stairs and running the water piping.
