“We are here today celebrating the legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King and our students are learning his dream is still alive. They are learning what it means to be equal, what it means for everyone to have an opportunity and a right to education and to have freedom,” said Principal BJ Brown-Lawson.

As the children marched, they chanted slogans such as Black Lives Matter; we want Freedom, Freedom for Immigrants, and Dr. Martin Luther King.

Ms. Ana Ramos, 5th Grade Teacher, said the students drew posters and wrote down their ideas and what they believe we should all be working and fighting for. Jhair Garcia wrote on his poster, “No to Drugs.” Angel Serrano, “Immigrants’ Rights” and Vanessa Garcia, “No to War.”

“We are here today giving the children an opportunity to share in some of the activities that they did many years ago,” said Mr. Princeton Hold, 4th Grade Substitute Teacher. “Teaching them in the classroom is one thing, giving them the opportunity of being able to go outside and showing them what it feels to demonstrate, is what today is about.”
